


ABOUTUS INTRODUCTION

The Virtual University is Pakistan's first public sector university based completely on modern Information and Communication Technologies with a clear mission: to provide extremely affordable world class education to aspiring students all over the country. The University opened its virtual doors in 2002 using television broadcasts and the Internet thereby allowing students to follow its rigorous programs regardless of their physical location. The objective was to alleviate the lack of capacity in existing institutions while simultaneously overcoming the acute shortage of qualified professors in the country.

By identifying the top professors of the country, regardless of their institutional affiliations, and requesting them to develop and deliver hand-crafted courses, the Virtual University aims at raising the standard of higher education in Pakistan by providing high quality, easily accessible and affordable world-class education not only to its own students but also to students of all other universities in the country. The University holds a Federal Charter, making its degrees recognized and accepted all over the country as well as overseas. Pakistani students residing overseas in several other countries have also enrolled in the University's programs.



The University relies on digital media, Internet and free-to-air satellite television broadcasts to impart education. The University has its own four television channels (VTV1, VTV2, VTV3 & VTV4) and students have the liberty to watch their lectures in the comfortable surroundings of their homes which become virtual classrooms of VU or at any of the many VU campuses spread all over the country. These lectures are also available in DVD format and can easily be purchased at a minimal cost from University's on-line Bookshop (http://bookshop.vu.edu.pk).

The lecture videos are also available on the globally popular forum YouTube site with a weblink http://www.youtube.com/vu. Over 6000 video lectures on YouTube make it one of the largest contributions by any university to the Open Education Resources (OER) movement. VU has now published all courses on its open courseware site (http://ocw.vu.edu.pk), and thereby joined the ranks with top universities of the world. VU's open courseware site has been ranked as the best new open courseware site for the year 2012 by the international OCW Consortium.

The students and teachers use the Internet to interact with each other. For this purpose, the Virtual University has developed an online Learning Management System (LMS) through which the students have 24/7 access to reading material, lecture videos, notes and prescribed texts. The students use this system to hold discussions with their class fellows and put questions to their teachers related to the course material, to which they receive comprehensive and timely replies from their respective course teachers. The LMS is also used to hand out assignments to students and hold pop quizzes and practice tests. This innovative and unique mechanism for the delivery of education adopted by VU offers a high degree of flexibility to students who may view the lectures at a time of their choice.

Examinations are conducted by the Virtual University in a formal strictly proctored environment. Exam centers are announced, examiners and invigilators are appointed and students are allowed to set their own date sheets during mid and final term examinations. Examinations are conducted electronically and each student receives unique exam paper.

Since the opening of virtual doors in 2002, the University has outreached hundred cities of the country with more than 170 Private Virtual Campuses and 27 VU owned campuses. These campuses provide the required infrastructure for studying and conducting the examinations for more than 100,000 students of the University. In addition, VU has established its own campuses at Abbottabad, Badin, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, Dera Ghazi Khan, Faisalabad, Gujar Khan, Ghotki, Gujranwala, Hyderabad, Islamabad, Jalalpur Pirwala, Jhelum, Karachi, Lahore, Makhdoom Rasheed, Multan, Muzaffargarh, Nankana Sahib, Peshawar, Pattoki, Qadirpur Raan, Quetta, Rawalpindi, Sahiwal and Sukkur with more to follow.

The Virtual University of Pakistan (VUP) laid the foundation of its Students' Societies with the aim to transform the minds and lives of its students through creative expressions. The founding member of "Life at VU" is Professor Dr. Muhammad Nawaz. Under his kind leadership, the Virtual University has successfully conducted three consecutive Student Week Events. 
VU Camera Club conducted Photography Competition with three different themes stated below:


